SUBJECT: Resolution approving the Sanitation District No. 1 to purchase a 900ECO 12

Yard Combination Sewer Cleaner Truck and Envirosight mainline inspection system crawler camera with remote controller and software for Lake Wildwood Zone 1 and Lake of the Pines Zone 2 and amend the budget for Fiscal Year 2025/26 and release fund balance (4/5 Affirmative Vote

Required) – Districts II and IV

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: A budget amendment is required in the amount of \$795,556.47 for Fiscal Year 2025/26 and there is sufficient fund balance in the Sanitation District Budget. There is no impact to the general fund.

BACKGROUND: In October 2025, the existing sewer cleaner truck that serves Lake Wildwood and Lake of the Pines Sanitation zones caught fire and was destroyed. An insurance claim has been filed, and the County's Risk Manager is seeking replacement costs in accordance with insurance reimbursement process. The need for a replacement sewer cleaner truck is imminent with the fast-approaching winter season when the truck is needed most for mitigating ground saturation and drainage support.

To determine the best approach to source the 900ECO 12 Yard Combination Sewer Cleaner Truck (replacement truck) in a timely manner, the Sanitation District collaborated with the Purchasing Division and determined a sole source award with U-Rock Utility and Equipment LLC of Sacramento, CA, is the most affordable vendor to fulfill the need. U-Rock currently has a new truck in stock (local in Sacramento) and offers a rent-to-own option with 75% of the rental fees being applied toward the purchase of the sewer truck. The truck being offered, also includes vacuum on-the-go mobility.

The Sanitation District requests approval to purchase a remote control, rover camera with software for sewer line inspection (Envirosight Rovver X Basic Mainline Inspection HD System camera with crawler and remote controller). The current camera system's software is no longer supported. The Envirosight Rovver X remote control camera offers mobility to inaccessible areas that current vehicles and equipment cannot get to. The camera will be used to troubleshoot and inspect lines. With the purchase of the Sewer Equipment 900ECO 12 Yard Combination Sewer Cleaner Truck, a 10% discount is available, to be applied at the time of invoice, on the remote-control camera equipment.

The rental agreement executed by the Purchasing Agent will end upon Board approval for the purchase

of the new truck and Purchasing Policy Section 7.1 (C) requires approval of the Board of Directors for goods/commodities above \$250,000. The cost of the new truck is \$668,317.03 and the cost of the remote-control camera rover is \$127,239.44, plus associated fees.
