**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving Amendment No.3 to Contract No. PESP4415 with Fire Safe Council of Nevada County to the purchasing contract PESP4415 between the County of Nevada and Fire Safe Council of Nevada County to provide for additional winter storm emergency response supporting the gathering and processing of green waste created by the 2021 winter storm event in Eastern Nevada County and authorizing the Purchasing Agent to execute the amendment

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution.

**FUNDING:** All costs for the services described in Amendment No.3 will not exceed the current maximum contract amount of \$250,000. Funding for the additional work performed under this amendment will be reimbursed by the Northern Sierra Air Quality Management District Grant which the Nevada County Board of Supervisors accepted on March 8<sup>th</sup> (Resolution 22-130).

**BACKGROUND:** On December 27, 2021, in the early morning, Nevada County was hit with an intense winter snow-storm (Snow-storm) bringing excessive amounts of snow to areas that typically receive little to no snow. As a result of the Snow-storm hundreds of trees and limbs have been downed across Nevada County creating an increased wildfire threat county wide.

The County entered into a contract with Fire Safe Council of Nevada County, effective January 3, 2022, for Winter Storm Support and Green Waste Mitigation. The contract was subsequently amended on January 8, 2022, to capture additional overhead labor rates, and amended again on March 8th, 2022, by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors (Resolution 22-123). Resolution 22-123 increased the not to exceed amount from \$50,000 to \$250,000 funding facilitation of the extremely successful Free Storm Debris Disposal drop off days in Western Nevada County as well as rights-of-way vegetation management services provided

during the initial response to the emergency.

If approved, this third amendment to the Fire Safe Council's contract will update the schedule of Services (Exhibit "A-1") to include facilitation and management of Eastern Nevada County Green Waste Collection days which will take place May 20<sup>th</sup>, June 4<sup>th</sup>, & June 17<sup>th</sup>, from 8:00am-2:00pm at the Truckee Rodeo Grounds, 10695 Brockway Road, Truckee, CA. This amendment will providing a central location for all Eastern Nevada County residents to drop off hazardous vegetation left by the winter storm event free of charge.
