SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing the Nevada County Sheriff to submit an

application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways, for reimbursement of boating safety enforcement costs for the period July 1, 2025, to June 30,

2026.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: Not applicable. This is an application for financial aid from California Department of Boating and Waterways to reimburse costs associated with the Sheriff's Office Boating and Safety Enforcement Program for Fiscal Year 2025/26.

BACKGROUND: The Sheriff's Office has participated in this enforcement program for over forty years. The Program allows the Sheriff's Office to assign specially trained deputies to proactively patrol the county's waterways throughout the summer months when the number of visitors to the area is at its peak. Funds received from this program and a portion of the personal property tax assessed on boats pay the cost of deputies' salaries and benefits, boats, training, maintenance, and other program related costs. Without this financial support our capacity for prevention efforts would not be viable and we would be limited to emergency response to watercraft law enforcement and boating safety violations on our county lakes.

Although we are requesting \$420,815.63 it is anticipated the funding will be more in line with prior year funding amounts of approximately \$96,000.
