**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving Amendment No. 1 to the personal services contract with the California Forensic Medical Group, Inc. for inmate medical services to address compensation for services that are covered by the Medi-Cal County Inmate Program (MCIP) and authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the amendment

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

**FUNDING:** California Forensic Medical Group, Inc. will reimburse the County 85% of reduced liability and annual MCIP Administrative Services share. There will be no negative impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** The County entered into a contract with California Forensic Medical Group, Inc. (CFMG) to provide medical services to inmates in county jail facilities, on January 1, 2016, approved by Resolution 16-046. After the execution of the contract with CFMG, the County elected to participate in the MCIP. The MCIP program allows claiming Medi-Cal Funds for services for which the county was previously responsible, resulting in potential savings to the County.

The County and CFMG now desire to amend the contract to address compensation for services that are covered by the MCIP program. Because of the County participation in MCIP, Nevada County and CFMG acknowledge there is a net reduction in CFMG's liability for medical treatment cost for individual inmate inpatient episodes. Accordingly, CFMG will reimburse annual MCIP Administrative Services share paid to Department of Healthcare Services (DHCS) and pay the non-federal share that will be invoiced from DHCS along with the paid claim analysis. CFMG will also reimburse the County 85% of the reduced liability.
