RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A WASHER-EXTRACTOR FOR USE AT NEVADA COUNTY JUVENILE HALL AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015 JUVENILE HALL AND PROBATION BUDGETS

WHEREAS, Juvenile Hall is responsible for the care and custody of youth detained in Juvenile Hall; and

WHEREAS, Minimum Standards for Juvenile Facilities Title 15 Regulations mandate clean clothing, bedding and linens be provided to detained youth; and

WHEREAS, Juvenile Hall requires a new heavy duty washer-extractor to perform ongoing laundry operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors approves the purchase of a washer-extractor for use in the Juvenile Hall and further directs the Auditor-Controller to amend the Probation and Juvenile Hall Budgets as follows:
