SUBJECT:	Resolution approving execution of a renewal contract with Recover Medical Group services for virtual outpatient individual and group rehabilitative treatment services, and recovery services, for Medi-Cal beneficiaries for the recovery and treatment of alcohol /drug dependency in the maximum amount of \$142,329 for the contract term of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Funding is provided through Drug Medi-Cal Federal reimbursement and 2011 Realignment. Services are within the Department's FY 23/24 budget and there are no County general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Recover Medical Group provides effective, accessible, and innovative virtual outpatient, intensive outpatient, care coordination, and recovery services to persons affected by Substance Use Disorders (SUD).

The evidenced-based treatment programs provided by Recover Medical Group are designed to help reach Nevada County individuals and families who live rurally, by providing a telehealth option. This is particularly helpful for residents in Truckee as well as for young people who may be more interested in the privacy and flexibility of virtual services. Recover Medical Group helps clients to achieve and maintain healthy and rewarding lives, leading to long-term selfsufficiency and the restoration of family systems.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Agreement as the services provided will help program participants achieve and maintain healthy and stable lives, leading to long-term self-sufficiency and the restoration of family systems. Renewal of this contract will allow critical services to continue for people who are struggling with substance use disorder needs.
