




Development Need



New Shelter Design

- Solicited Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for construction document design
- LDA Partners, Inc. determined most qualified
- Collaborative design process planned

Recommendations

- Approve Resolution executing a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the County of Nevada, City of Grass Valley, and City of Nevada City for collaboration with animal shelter development and services.
- Approve Resolution establishing a contract with LDA Partners, Inc. for architectural design services for the Nevada County Animal Shelter Project with the maximum contract price of \$1,850,000, with a contingency of \$185,000, for a total of \$2,035,000 authorizing the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the Contract and amend the Fiscal Year 2023-24 Capitol Facilities Budget.
