**SUBJECT:** Resolution accepting the Amendment Modification Summary (E-76) authorizing additional funding for the construction phase of the Hirschdale Road at UPRR Overcrossing Rehabilitation Project in the amount of \$127,000, Federal Aid Project #BRLO-5917(097) – District V

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached resolution.

**FUNDING:** The Hirschdale Road at UPRR Overcrossing Rehabilitation Project is funded with Highway Bridge Program (HBP) funds. This project is in the current Department of Public Works Capital Improvement Plan and impacts Fiscal Year 25/26 Road Engineering Budget. A budget amendment is not required and there is no impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:** The State has prepared an additional Amendment Modification Summary (E-76), dated June 6, 2025, authorizing an increase in the amount of the award by \$127,000 for the Construction Phase for a total federal funding amount of \$4,501,000. Approval from the Board of Supervisors is required to accept these funds.
