RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE NORTH SAN JUAN FIRE FLOW FEASIBILITY STUDY PREPARED BY SAUERS ENGINEERING, INC., APPROVED UNDER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT 13-CDBG-8931 BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (HCD) FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved execution of Standard Agreement 13-CDBG-8931 between the County of Nevada and the State Housing and Community Development (HCD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program per Resolution 14-041; and

WHEREAS, the funding of this project is provided by the State Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) awarded and executed per Standard Agreement No. 13-CDBG-8931 in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 with a County General Fund match of \$2,500; and

WHEREAS, this agreement under the planning and technical assistance category authorized the development of a Fire Flow Feasibility Study to be conducted for the community of North San Juan in accordance with HCD regulations through the release of an RFQ; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved the County of Nevada Health and Human Services Agency through the Housing and Community Services Program to solicit Request for Proposals for the Fire Flow Feasibility Study per Resolution 15-505 and Sauers Engineering, Inc. submitted the successful proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved the County of Nevada Health and Human Services Agency through the Housing and Community Services Program to enter into a contract with Sauers Engineering, Inc. to prepare the Fire Flow Feasibility Study per Resolution 16-087 and 16-350.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the County of Nevada Board of Supervisors:

1. Received and reviewed the completed North San Juan Fire Flow Feasibility Study prepared by Sauers Engineering, Inc. and submitted by the Health and Human Services Agency through the Housing and Community Services Program.
