## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING NEVADA COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH'S MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT (BHSA) IMPLEMENTATION INNOVATION PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 24/25 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 26/27 AND AUTHORIZES THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DIRECTION TO SUBMIT THE PLAN TO THE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES OVERSIGHT AND ACCOUNTABILITY COMMISSION (MHSOAC)

WHEREAS, the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), adopted by the California electorate on November 2, 2004, created a new revenue source for the transformation and enhancement of public mental health services; and

WHEREAS, the current components of the MHA Plan are: Community Service and Supports (CSS), Workforce, Education and Training (WET), Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI), and Innovation (INN); and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department desires approval for its Behavioral Health Services Act (BHSA) Implementation Innovation Plan for Fiscal Years 24/25 through 26/27; and

WHEREAS, MHSA regulations require that the Board of Supervisors approve or have a scheduled meeting to approve the Innovation Plan before it is heard by the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) for final approval; and

WHEREAS, consistent with statutory requirement, the Draft Innovation Plan was posted for a public comment period from September 4, 2024 through October 4, 2024, and the proposed Plan has been available on the County website for review and comments. The final public hearing was held at our local Mental Health and Substance Use Advisory Board meeting on October 4, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, approves the Nevada County Behavioral Health's Mental Health Services Act Innovation Plan for Fiscal Year 24/25 through Fiscal Year 26/27 and authorizes the Behavioral Health Direction to submit the Plan to the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC).
