## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO AND PARTICIPATION IN THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CONTINUUM INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM ("BHCIP")

WHEREAS, The California Department of Health Care Services, through its contractor Advocates for Human Potential, Inc., ("Department") has issued a Request for Applications, dated January 31, 2022 ("RFA"), for the BHCIP Program ("Program"); and

WHEREAS, The Department has issued the RFA for Program grant funds pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Sections 5960-5960.45; and

WHEREAS, Program grant funds are derived primarily from the federal Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recover Funds, which was established by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, and in part from the State of California General Fund; and

WHEREAS, The County of Nevada ("Applicant"), desires to apply for Program grant funds by submitting an application for Program funds ("Application") to the Department for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, The Department is authorized to administer BHCIP pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 5960-5960.45. Program funding allocations are subject to the terms and conditions of the RFA, the Application, Standard Agreement ("Standard Agreement"), and all other legal requirements of the Program.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that:

- 1. Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to submit an Application to the Department in response to the RFA, and to apply for Program grant funds in a total amount not to exceed \$1,999,975.
- 2. If the Application is approved, Applicant is hereby authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver a Standard Agreement in a total amount not to exceed \$1,999,975, any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to secure the Program funds from the Department and to participate in the Program, and all amendments thereto (collectively, the "Program Documents").

- 3. Applicant acknowledges and agrees that it shall be subject to the terms and conditions specified in the Standard Agreement. Any and all activities, expenditures, information, and timelines represented in the Application are enforceable through the Standard Agreement. Funds are to be used for the allowable expenditures and activities identified in the Standard Agreement.\
- 4. That the Chair of the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Child Support, Housing and Community Services (the "Authorized Signatory"), to execute the Application and the Program Documents on behalf of Applicant for participation in the Program; and Applicant further agrees and authorizes the Authorized Signatory to execute the Declaration of Restrictions and Performance Deed of Trust to be recorded against the Project located at 1101-1105 Sutton Way, Grass Valley, CA 95945, as more particularly described in the Program Funding Agreement.
