



RESOLUTION No. 25-350

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH FREED FOR INDEPENDENT LIVING FOR FUNDING TO ADMINISTER THE SOARWORKS PROGRAM TO ELIGIBLE CLIENTS IN THE TOTAL MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2025, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026

WHEREAS, Freed For Independent Living is an agency which supports independent living for adults with disabilities and older adults; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services wishes to enter into a renewal contract with FREED who will coordinate outreach, case management, housing assistance and disability advocacy to eligible participants utilizing the SOARWorks program; and

WHEREAS, FREED will work in collaboration with the Continuum of Care and the Coordinated Entry System to ensure populations with the highest needs are given the highest priority and are able to access SOARWorks services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and Freed For Independent Living for the provision of services pertaining to assisting individuals with disabilities who are experiencing homelessness to apply for disability benefit programs while also providing housing assistance for the term of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026 in the total maximum amount of \$100,000 is approved and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada.
