OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH THOMSON REUTERS' WEST PUBLISHING CORPORATION REGARDING ONLINE LEGAL RESEARCH, LEGAL CALENDARING AND LEGAL DOCUMENT PREPARATION SOFTWARE, AND RELATED SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$33,191.44 FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2019 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Office of the County Counsel serves as in-house counsel and provides a wide array of legal services for the County of Nevada, including litigation services; and

WHEREAS, online legal research, calendaring and other technology-based support services are the most cost-effective and efficient way to maintain the resources necessary to operate and manage in-house legal services and ensure that the office remains current on legal issues; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement with Thomson Reuters for legal research and other support services, for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019, Resolution 16-286; and

WHEREAS, County Counsel's office desires to renew the Agreement for bundled online legal support services for a new three-year term commencing July 1, 2019, with a termination date of June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Thomson Reuters is a leading provider of legal publications, online research services, case management and calendaring programs and other legal support services, and is willing and well qualified to provide such services to the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Agreement by and between the County of Nevada and Thomson Reuters' West Publishing Corporation for West Proflex On-line Legal Research, Legal Calendaring, and Legal Document Preparation Software in the amount of \$33,191.44 for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022 (\$10,738.44 in Fiscal Year 2019-20; \$11,060.59 in Fiscal Year 2020-21; and \$11,392.41 in Fiscal Year 2021-22) be and hereby is approved in the form attached hereto and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement.
