SUBJECT: Resolution approving the Agreement between the City of Grass Valley and the Nevada County Probation Department for AB109 police officer services for the fiscal year 2026/27.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

FUNDING: The Agreement amount of \$100,000 for fiscal year 2026/27, is 100% funded by State Local Community Corrections Account apportionment (AB109). Funding is included in the fiscal year 2026/27 budget. No general funds are required.

BACKGROUND:

Since the inception of AB109 in 2011, Nevada County Probation has successfully developed multiple programs and resources within the community to address the needs of probationers released from, or eligible for, State prison sentences. Nevada County is very fortunate to have a tradition of excellent collaboration among the Courts, Probation, Sheriff, Police Departments, District Attorney, Public Defender, Health and Human Services, Community Based Organizations and the faith-based community. Members of the Nevada County Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) are committed to working closely together to assess, implement, maintain, refine, and increase services funded by AB109.

For fiscal year 2026/27, the CCP Executive Committee agreed the City of Grass Valley may receive a distribution of Nevada County AB109 Realignment funds in the maximum amount of \$100,000 for an Outreach Liaison Officer. This Agreement allows for the funding of a uniformed police officer to work with clients with co-occurring substance use disorders (SUD), serious mental health disorders, trauma histories, and criminogenic risk factors. Services as approved by the CCP are being implemented as of July 1, 2026, with the understanding that this Agreement's effective date will be backdated to reflect the full term of July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2027. Proactive outreach to homeless individuals and/or individuals in crisis will be prioritized in an effort to reduce the likelihood of future criminal justice involvement through early intervention.
