OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING NEVADA COUNTY'S ANNUAL MATCH CONTRIBUTION FUNDING PURSUANT TO THE AREA 4 AGENCY ON AGING JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$54,473 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024/25

WHEREAS, per Resolution 83-80, the Board of Supervisors approved a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) between seven California Counties (Nevada, Placer, Sierra, Sutter, Sacramento, Yolo, and Yuba) pertaining to participation in the seven-county JPA for the new Area 4 Agency on Aging (A4AA); and

WHEREAS, under this JPA, A4AA works to provide critical services for our aging population within Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, financial support from Nevada County, as well as the other six counties who are parties to the JPA, ensures the quality and content of A4AA's services; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that in fiscal year 2024/25, A4AA will be able to leverage an estimated \$1,167,349 in Federal and State grants for nutrition, transportation, legal assistance, information and assistance, long-term care ombudsmen and other supportive services in Nevada County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the annual Match Contribution funding pursuant to the Area 4 Agency on Aging Joint Powers Agreement in the maximum amount of \$54,473 for fiscal year 2024/25 be and hereby is approved.
