RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF DISPATCH RECORDER EQUIPMENT AND SOFTWARE BY CAL OES 9-1-1 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS BRANCH, ON BEHALF OF NEVADA COUNTY, TO REPLACE EXISTING EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$55,116.86 AND TO ACCEPT AS A CAPITAL ASSET

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office provides regional dispatch services for Nevada County, including the City of Grass Valley, the Town of Truckee, the City of Nevada City including the operations of the State 9-1-1 program for the County; and


WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office is mandated to record all 9-1-1 calls for service and the current recording equipment is outdated and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Eventide 740 DX advanced recording equipment is eligible to be funded by the Cal OES 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch (9-1-1 Branch) as part of the Customer Premise Equipment (CPE) funding designated for the County of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the 9-1-1 Branch will purchase the recording equipment on behalf of the Nevada County Sheriff's Office and the Sheriff's Office would own the equipment and therefore be a capital asset of the County of Nevada.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of Nevada:

- 1) Approves the Sheriff's Office to request purchase of dispatch recording equipment by Cal OES 9-1-1 Branch in the amount of \$55,116.86; and
- 2) Authorizes the Sheriff, or her designee, to sign any documentation as may be required by Cal OES 9-1-1 Branch for such purchase and to take possession of the equipment; and
- 3) Approves the dispatch recording equipment as a capital asset.
