SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of a renewal contract with Common

Purpose for the provision of recovery residence services for Nevada County Medi-Cal beneficiaries in the maximum amount of \$222,000

for Fiscal Year 23/24.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** Funding is provided with SABG (Substance Abuse Block Grant) monies and 2011 Realignment. Services are included in the Department's FY 23/24 budget and there are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

## **BACKGROUND:**

Common Purpose provides education and treatment services to persons affected by substance use disorders. The treatment programs provided by Common Purpose are designed to help individuals and families achieve and maintain healthy and rewarding lives leading to long-term self-sufficiency and the restoration of family systems.

Recovery Residences services will be for male and female adults (over the age of 18) and their children as authorized by the County Behavioral Health Department. Recovery Residences provide an affordable clean and sober supported living environment where individuals can rebuild their own housing and employment resources while still participating in a lower level of care.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Agreement as the services provided will help program participants achieve and maintain healthy and stable lives, leading to long-term selfsufficiency and the restoration of family systems.
