SUBJECT: Resolution Amending Various Nevada County Budgets Through the

Third Consolidated Budget Amendment for the 2023-24 Fiscal Year

(4/5 affirmative vote required)

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

FUNDING: Various

BACKGROUND: Occasionally it becomes necessary to adjust the original adopted budget for new initiatives, newly identified grant or external funding or inaccurate budget estimates or unexpected costs. This proposed amendment is the second consolidated budget amendment for this fiscal year. The budget amendment reflects activity in a variety of departments.

Here is a summary of budget impacts to the General Fund and department special revenue funds:

The individual adjustments are denoted on Attachment A.

Here are some highlights of the consolidated budget amendment:

- CW3AD14 reflects the reclassification of budget for the administration of the County animal shelter contract from IGS Administration into the newly created Animal Shelter budget unit, along with an increase of \$50,000 related to unbudgeted maintenance needs.
- CW3AD36 facilitates the redistribution of General Fund Maintenance of Effort funds from the Roads Admin budget into Fleet Road Equipment to support essential equipment replacements.
- CW3AD63 establishes capital asset budget for the \$1.6M federal earmark funded Radio Infrastructure Upgrade Project.

Attachment B lists the following capital assets, which are included for approval in this budget amendment:

- Overall increase to previously approved vehicle replacement capital asset costs in Fleet Management: \$108,136
- Radio Infrastructure Upgrade Project costs in Sheriff's Office: \$1,407,246
- High Frequency Radio Project radios in Sheriff's Office: \$14,299
- 3x Health Access Vending Machines, 1x Fit Testing Machine and 1x Portable Xray Machine in Public Health: \$74,248
- 1x accounting true up for an asset approved in the prior year in Economic Development: \$10,000
