OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO BRING THE CALIFORNIA STATE VICTIM NOTIFICATION SERVICE (VINE) TO THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

WHEREAS, the California State Victim Notification service (VINE) is available to the County of Nevada, free of charge until January 2010, from the California State Sheriff's Association; and

WHEREAS; the County of Nevada supports the rights of victims of crime; and

WHEREAS; the Sheriff can use the technology offered to send jail information to a central database where citizens may request notification, via phone call or email, regarding the release of prisoners from our jail facilities; and

WHEREAS, per Penal Code 4024.4, the Board of Supervisors must approve this type of notification system, prior to implementation..

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Sheriff to bring the VINE service to the County of Nevada and directs Information Systems to facilitate the installation of the VINE computer.


