OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING ACCEPTANCE OF ADDITIONAL BEHAVIORAL HEALTH BRIDGE HOUSING FUNDS AND EXECUTION OF MODIFICATION #1 TO THE SUBCONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH ADVOCATES FOR HUMAN POTENTIAL, INC. ON BEHALF OF THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$9,392,984 (AN INCREASE OF \$2,791,170) FOR THE CONTRACT TERM OF JUNE 23, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027 AND DIRECTS THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO AMEND THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/26 (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) made available additional grant funds to county behavioral health agencies for the delivery of Behavioral Health Bridge Housing (BHBH) Programs; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of BHBH funding is to address the immediate housing and treatment needs of people experiencing unsheltered homelessness with serious behavioral health concerns through increasing housing options and providing ongoing supports; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County has identified the need to address housing and homelessness as a board priority; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County Behavioral Health was awarded an additional allocation of grant funding to support a local BHBH program to increase housing options for individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness; and

WHEREAS, this additional allocation of grant funds will be utilized in partnership with Foothill House of Hospitality (d/b/a Hospitality House) to increase available housing for individuals experiencing homelessness with the purchase and renovation of housing units; and

WHEREAS, Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. has been contracted by DHCS as the contract administrator for BHBH Programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Behavioral Health Bridge Housing Program award modification adding additional funding be accepted and the amended subcontract agreement by and between the County and Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. pertaining to the provision of BHBH Program services for the contract term of June 23, 2023 through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount of \$9,392,984 (an increase of \$2,791,170) be hereby approved, and that the Director of Behavioral Health be and is hereby authorized to execute the modified subcontract agreement, and subsequent related routine grant documents, on behalf of the County of Nevada and directs the Auditor-Controller to amend Behavioral Health's budget as follows:
