SUBJECT: Acceptance of the 2018 Nevada County Annual Crop and Livestock

Report

RECOMMENDATION: Accept the report

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to California Food and Agriculture Code Section 2279, the commissioner shall compile a report of acreage, production, and value of agricultural products in their county. In 2018, the gross value of raw agricultural products produced in Nevada County was \$25,609,200. This is a 7.3% increase over the 2017 value. When combined with wine grape crops, our Fruit & Nut Crops saw the largest gain (20.6% increase) followed timber (20.6% increase). Also, after three years of declines, our livestock industry, which is the county's highest valued commodity, experienced a slight 3.7% gain.

In addition to the farm gate values reported, this year we included a special report on the multiplier effects that Nevada County Agriculture has on the local economy. This report shows that an estimated \$7.7 million additional dollars are brought to the economy directly because of agriculture.

Part two of the report explores the ecosystems supported by Nevada County Agriculture and tries to assign a rough dollar value estimate, \$420 million to \$1.203 billion per year, however we found that validating and refining this estimate would require significant further research.

This report paints the fullest picture of Nevada County Agriculture to date.
