OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING A STANDARD PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND CME SERVICES FOR THE ERIC ROOD ADMINISTRATION CENTER HELLING CROSSWALK PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,381 PLUS A CONTINGENCY OF \$2,039 FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$22,420, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, construction documents were prepared and approved through Resolution 19-086 for the project known as the Eric Rood Administration Center Helling Crosswalk; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were solicited and four timely bids for this project were received and opened on March 19, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive and responsible bid was from CME Services of Grass Valley, California, in the amount of \$20,381; and

WHEREAS, the contract will be in the bid amount of \$20,381 plus a 10% contingency of \$2,039 for a maximum contract amount of \$22,420; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be paid out of the Fiscal Year 2018-19 Facilities Management budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby directs that:

1. The contract for the Eric Rood Administration Center Helling Crosswalk Project located at the Eric Rood Administration Center 950 Maidu Avenue at the intersection of Maidu Avenue and Helling Way, Nevada City, California, in the amount of \$20,381 plus a contingency of \$2,039 for a total contract amount of \$22,420 be awarded to CME Services, 900 Golden Gate Terrace "D", Grass Valley, California, 95945.
2. The Board approves and the Board Chair is authorized to execute a Nevada County standard public works contract on behalf of Nevada County with CME Services upon receipt, approval, and acceptance of the certificates of insurance.
3. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to execute change orders pursuant to Paragraph 9 of the Contract, up to the total contingency amount of \$2,039.
4. Contractor shall commence the work 10 days after mailing of written notice to proceed by County. All work shall be completed and ready for acceptance on or before 45 days of the mailing of the Notice to Proceed.
