**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of a grant close-out agreement and release of obligation from the grant agreement executed between Nevada County Behavioral Health and Advocates for Human Potential through Resolution 22-208 for the Department of Health Care Services Crisis Care Mobile Units Grant.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** There is no funding attached to this agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** In 2022 Nevada County Behavioral Health received funding through the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Crisis Care Mobile Units (CCMU). The funding was for California county, city, or tribal entities to implement new and enhanced CCMUs. DHCS contracted with Advocates for Human Potential (AHP) to administer the CCMU grant. These grant funds were used to implement and enhance the 24/7 mobile crisis teams administered through Nevada County Behavioral Health in partnership with Sierra Mental Wellness Group. The CCMU grant ended on June 30, 2025. Advocates for Human Potential is requesting that grantees sign a grant close-out letter as a release of obligation from the grant agreement.

It is recommended that the Board approve this release as it provides for grant close out, final grant fund payout, and release of obligation from the grant terms for the DHCS Crisis Care Mobile Units Grant administered through Advocates for Human Potential.
