

RESOLUTION No._____ OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE NEVADA COUNTY ZERO EMISSION VEHICLE (ZEV) TRANSITION PLAN

WHEREAS, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) adopted the Advanced Clean Fleet (ACF) regulation requiring 100% of all small county municipalities Medium Heavy-Duty (MHD) purchases be zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs) starting in 2027; and

WHEREAS, the ACF Regulation applies to any municipality fleet of vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 8,500 or greater; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County Transportation Commission received a grant that funded the development of the transition plan; and

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2024, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors received a presentation of the Draft Zero Emission Vehicle Transition Plan and were asked to provide feedback to incorporate into the final plan; and

WHEREAS Momentum, Frontier Energy, DKS Associates, and Sugarpine Engineering have produced the final Nevada County Zero Emission Vehicle Transition Plan, incorporating feedback provided after the draft transition plan presentation to the Nevada County Board of Supervisors on May 14, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the transition plan will take place in three phases, over 29 years, from 2024-2053; and

WHEREAS, the plan is ready for Board approval; and

WHEREAS, staff will continue to ensure any State or Federal legislative changes are incorporated into our Transition Plan and brought forward to the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Nevada County Zero Emission Vehicle Transition Plan.
