



RESOLUTION No. 17-422

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN COUNTY PROPERTY AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASING AGENT TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Sections 25504 and 25365 of the California Government Code authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish regulations whereby the County Purchasing Agent may, by direct sale or otherwise, sell or dispose of any personal property belonging to the County of Nevada not being required for public use, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has adopted the Nevada County Administrative Code and provided regulations for the disposal of surplus county personal property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that certain personal property is surplus to the needs of Nevada County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that provided that this Resolution shall be adopted by a four-fifths majority, the Purchasing Agent of the County of Nevada is authorized and directed to sell, or otherwise dispose of County Assets #26696, a snow plow blade acquired in 2006, and #26552, a card access security management system acquired in 2004 and 2005.
