What are Indigent Legal Defense Services?

- Constitutionally guaranteed right to legal representation
- In California, responsibility for providing and funding legal representation for those who cannot afford counsel falls to each individual county
- Nevada County meets this responsibility primarily through a County Public Defender's Office ("PD")
- When there is a conflict that prevents PD from representing a client, representation provided by an outside attorney



Background

- Superior Court ("Court") assigns outside counsel when PD cannot manage a case ("Conflict Case").
- Increasingly challenging to find enough local attorneys to meet Conflict Case demands
 - County and Court met to collaboratively identify solutions
- RFP Issued seeking a firm or group of attorneys to be a single point of contact to meet Conflict Case needs



Proposed Contract

- Cohen Defense Group ("CDG") provides similar services to Placer County
- Proposal recommended by all participants on RFP review panel, which included representation from the Court and PD.
- CDG will serve as single point of contact for Court in assignment of Conflict Cases
- Fixed annual price with offices established in both Western and Eastern county



Fiscal Impact

5-Year average of Budgeted Attorney Costs: \$416,459

Fiscal Impact (continued)

- Recent caseloads and corresponding costs likely artificially low due to the COVID-19 impact on court schedules
- In the absence of a solution to Conflict Caseload problem, Court will likely need rely more on out-of-area attorneys, which would come at a higher cost
- Contract allows for a utilization review, wherein the cost may be reduced if caseload demands do not justify the proposed costs
- Estimated costs for the County to establish internal conflict office are essentially the same as those included in the proposed contract



Agreement with Placer County

- Costs for services in the Truckee area will be shared with Placer County
 - Results in cost savings for Nevada County, estimated at 12%
- Agreement by and between the two counties is presented along with the contract



In Summary...

- Proposed contract the result of a collaborative process between Court and County to solve a persistent problem
- Proposed contract supported by all stakeholders
- Agreement supports collaboration with Placer County to reduce costs while meeting needs of Eastern county
- Annual budgetary increase of approximately \$472,000
