OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE 2024 ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR (OR INTERIM DIRECTOR) TO FILE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION - DISTRICTS I, II & IV

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works performs annual road maintenance on county roadways; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A includes a road list and map of 13.9 of roadways that require maintenance and preservation of their surfaces to correct asphalt distress and preserve and protect the underlying pavement structure; and

WHEREAS, work performed under this Environmental Clearance will be funded by Road Fund, PRD Long Valley Road and CSA 24 Zone 1 and Zone 2; and

WHEREAS, Fiscal Year 2023/24 Road Fund and PRD Long Valley budgets include this project, but may require a budget amendment upon the final award amount; and

WHEREAS, both PRD Long Valley Road and CSA 24, Zone 1 and Zone 2 have sufficient fund balances to amend their budgets when the contract is awarded; and

WHEREAS, under Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act Statutes and Guidelines, Class 1 projects consisting of the repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public facilities involving negligible, or no expansion of use, are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorizes environmental clearance for the 2024 Road Rehabilitation Project.
2. Authorizes the Director (or Interim Director) of the Nevada County Department of Public Works to file a Notice of Exemption with the Nevada County Clerk-Recorder's Office for the 2024 Road Rehabilitation Project.
