SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of a renewal Training Services Agreement # EW -2026-24 with The Regents of the University of California, UC Davis Extension, for thirty training units, to be provided to the County during fiscal year 2026/27, in the maximum amount of \$118,575.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Resolution approving execution of a renewal Training Services Agreement # EW -2026-24 with The Regents of the University of California, UC Davis Extension for thirty training units, to be provided to the County during fiscal year 2026/27, in the maximum amount of \$118,575, and to be funded through available State and Federal sources. Services were included in the Department budget and there are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: The County has contracted with the University of California Davis for over twenty years to provide an Eligibility Services Training Program. Human Services Specialists are responsible for carrying out well defined rules and regulations pertaining to various categorical aid programs and explaining them to applicants and the general public.

This year's Agreement includes the provision of thirty units of training for the County to supplement the Eligibility & Employment internal training program. The UC Davis Continuing and Professional Education Training curriculum includes: CalWORKs, CalFresh, Medi-Cal and IHSS (In-Home Supportive Services) eligibility, CalWORKs employment services, clerical, supervisory, management, fiscal, adult social services, cultural awareness, and civil rights training.
