OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NEVADA COUNTY SHERIFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS, FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF BOATING SAFETY ENFORCEMENT COSTS FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2025, TO JUNE 30, 2026

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada wishes to support law enforcement patrol on waterways within Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office wishes to submit an application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways, for financial aid to partially reimburse boating safety enforcement costs associated with their Boating Safety and Enforcement Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of the agreement, the County of Nevada stipulates that Harbors and Navigation Code, Section 663.7(e) which states: "The department shall not allocate funds to any county or a public agency within a county unless the department receives a resolution adopted annually by the board of supervisors authorizing the county to participate in the program and certifying that the county will expend for boating safety programs during that year not less than an amount equal to 100 percent of the amount received by the county from personal property taxes on vessels. The money allocated to a county pursuant to subdivision (a) shall be used only for boating safety and enforcement programs, as specified in subdivision (a), that are conducted in that county" shall apply; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office will request approval from the Nevada County Board of Supervisors if the monies are awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of Nevada authorizes:

- 1) The Sheriff to submit an application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways, for financial aid in the amount of \$420,815.63, pertaining to reimbursement of Boat Patrol operations, for the period July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026;
- 2) Authorizes the Sheriff to sign the Grant Application as well as any Certifications; and
- 3) Authorizes the Auditor/Controller to certify prior year vessel taxes.
