

# ORDINANCE No. 2527

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION A OF SECTION G-IV 8.26 OF ARTICLE 8 OF CHAPTER IV OF THE GENERAL CODE OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF PARCEL CHARGES WITHIN EASTERN NEVADA COUNTY EFFECTIVE JULY 13, 2023

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

#### SECTION I:

Section G-IV 8.26 of Chapter IV, Article 8 of the General Code of the County of Nevada is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### **SECTION II:**

### Sec. G-IV 8.26 Parcel Charges - Eastern Nevada County

A. Parcel charges are hereby established effective, per the table listed below, for solid waste disposal services as provided (in whole or in part) by the County of Nevada for all real property located in County Service Area 7 (CSA 7) and tax rate areas 77004, 77005, 77007, 77009, 77014, 77025, 77029, 77030, 77032, 77034, 77043, 77038, and 77063 as follows:

Improved Single Family/Multi-Family Residential Parcels within the unincorporated area of Eastern Nevada County:

7/1/2028 and all future years thereafter	Annual rate to be calculated based on the producer price index for solid waste, published in February of each year, with 3% minimum and 5% maximum effective July 1 of each year.

Any parcel for which a parcel charge has been levied under this section and which В. is permanently undevelopable or unusable under the provisions of the Nevada County Zoning Ordinance may, upon application for an adjustment following the procedures set forth in Section G-IV 8.25.C.1, be classified as a "no use" parcel and the parcel charge shall be removed therefrom.

#### **SECTION III:**

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and adopted this ordinance and each section, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

#### SECTION IV:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the expiration of thirty (30) days from and after its passage, and it shall become operative on the 13th day of July, 2023, and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the Supervisors voting for and against same in the Sierra Sun, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Nevada.
