**BACKGROUND:**

Currently there are two vacancies on the Adult & Family Services Commission. Low-Income Sector Representative and Public Sector Representative. These vacancies were advertised and posted for a minimum of ten days at the following places: the Board of Supervisors Chambers bulletin board, the Board of Supervisors office, and the County website. Notice was also posted at the Truckee Town Hall and the District V Board of Supervisors office in Truckee.

Deborah McDonald submitted an application for appointment to the Commission on March 17, 2026. At the Adult & Family Services Commission meeting on April 14, 2026, the commission recommended Deborah for appointment as a Private Sector Representative.

Louise Reed submitted an application for reappointment to the Commission on March 30, 2026. Louise has served on the Adult & Family Services Commission since July 9, 2024, and is a member in good standing. On April 14, 2026, the Commission recommended Louise Reed for reappointment as a Low-Income Sector Representative.

Kimberly Grant was appointed to the position of Public Sector Representative to the Adult & Family Services Commission on August 8, 2023. At the Adult & Family Services Commission meeting on April 14, 2026, the commission accepted her resignation.
