SUBJECT: Resolution approving the authorization to designate noncompetitive No Place Like Home (NPLH) Funds as committed financing for the Competitive NPLH Application pertaining to the Brunswick Commons NPLH project.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: The NPLH program funding referenced in these resolutions is from the State of California, pursuant to an appropriation provided by Government Code section 15463, Part 3.9 of Division 5 (commencing with Section 5849.1) of the Welfare and Institutions Code, and Welfare and Institutions Code section 5890.

BACKGROUND: NPLH was established by Part 3.9 of Division 5 of the Welfare and Institutions Code (commencing with Section 5849.1) and enacted in 2016 to further the purposes of the Mental Health Services Act. In November of 2018, voters approved Proposition 2, settling a court challenge and fully funding and implementing the NPLH program.

The purpose of this item is to designate the County allocation of noncompetitive funds (\$500,000) to be used as financing for the Brunswick Commons competitive NPLH project application. The allocated NPLH noncompetitive funds were accepted by the Board by RES 19-043 on January 22, 2019. A competitive application for NPLH funds, submitted on January 28, 2019, included a supplemental application listing the noncompetitive funds as financing leverage for the Brunswick Commons NPLH project.

The competitive NPLH project has since met threshold requirements for consideration of funding by State Housing and Community Development evaluators and has been moved to the “feasibility phase” in the competitive application process. This new resolution is required by HCD as part of

the “feasibility phase” review and will further designate noncompetitive funds be used as committed financing for the competitive NPLH application.
