SUBJECT: Resolution adopting a list of projects for Fiscal Year 2024/25 funded

by SB1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Funding is provided by Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) grants estimated at \$4 million as budgeted in the FY2024/25 Roads Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) budget. There is no general fund impact.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide. SB1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Nevada County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year.

SB1 requires Nevada County to adopt a resolution approving an annual list of projects scheduled to receive funding in fiscal year 2024/25 from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB1. Projects must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement. Overall, California State Association of Counties (CSAC) is estimating Nevada County will receive \$4,203,670 in RMRA funding in fiscal year 2024/25.

The Fiscal Year 2024/25 list of projects funded by RMRA revenues are found in Attachment 2 hereto and include the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Program.
