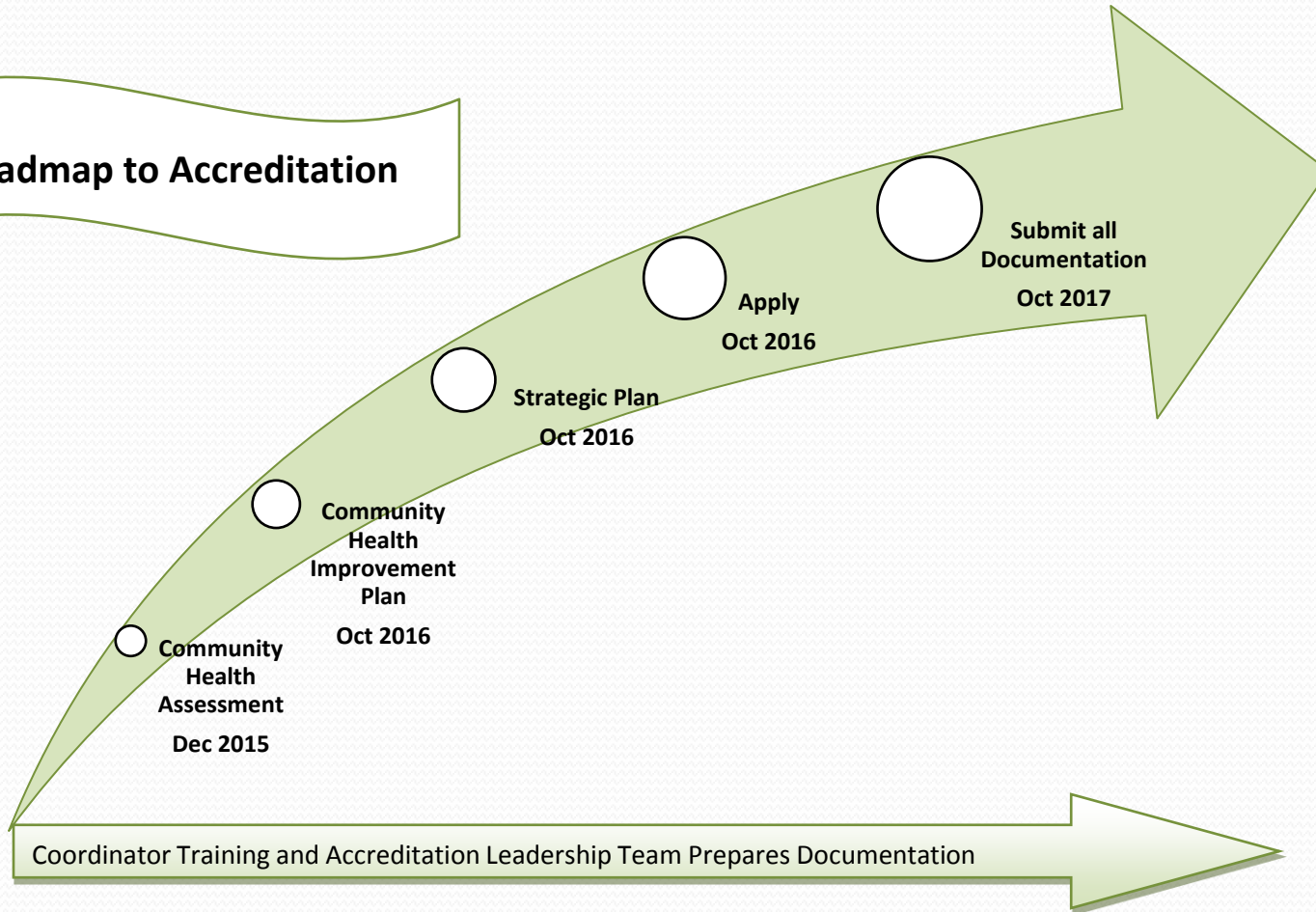

National Public Health Accreditation

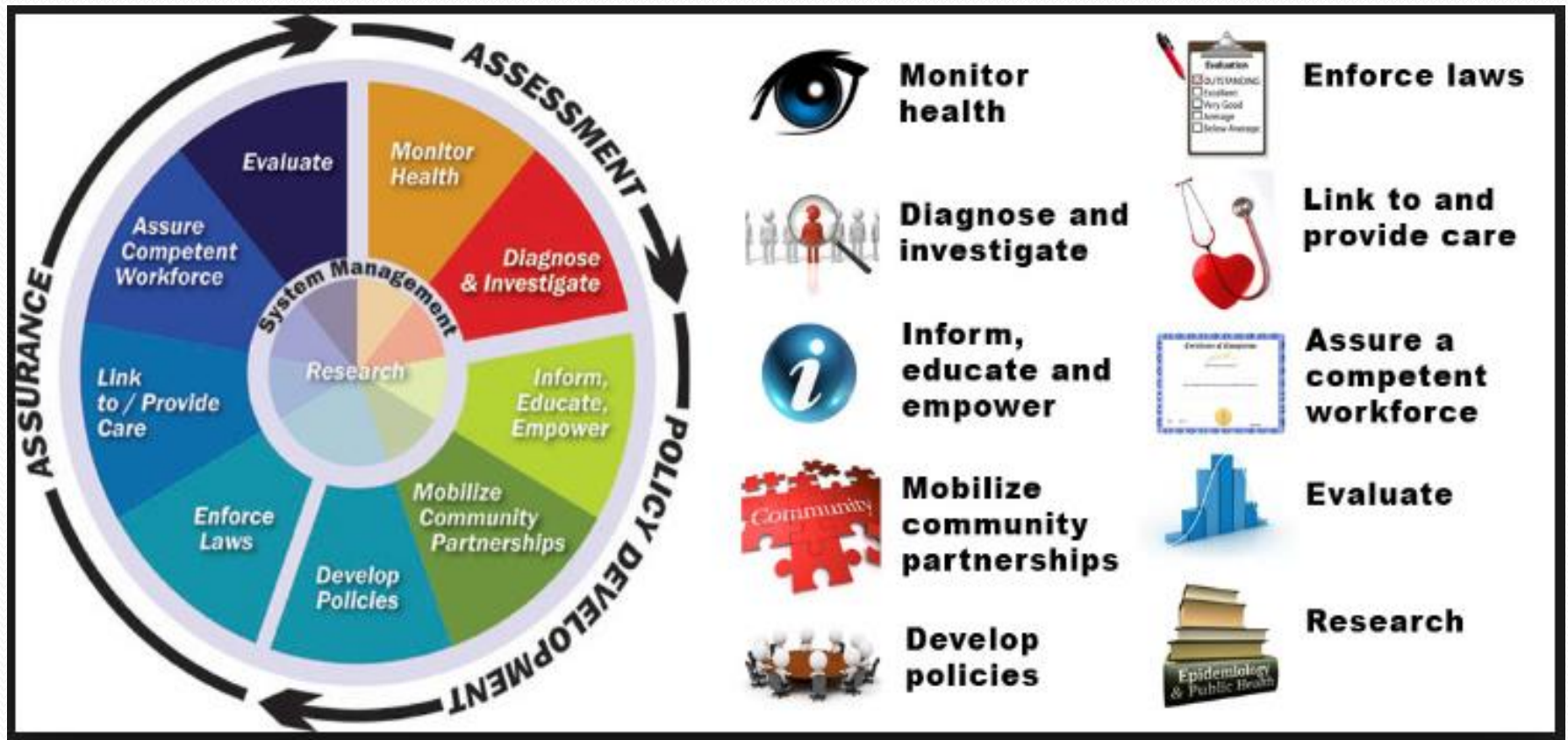
Public health department accreditation consists of

- recognition for those that meet the standards.

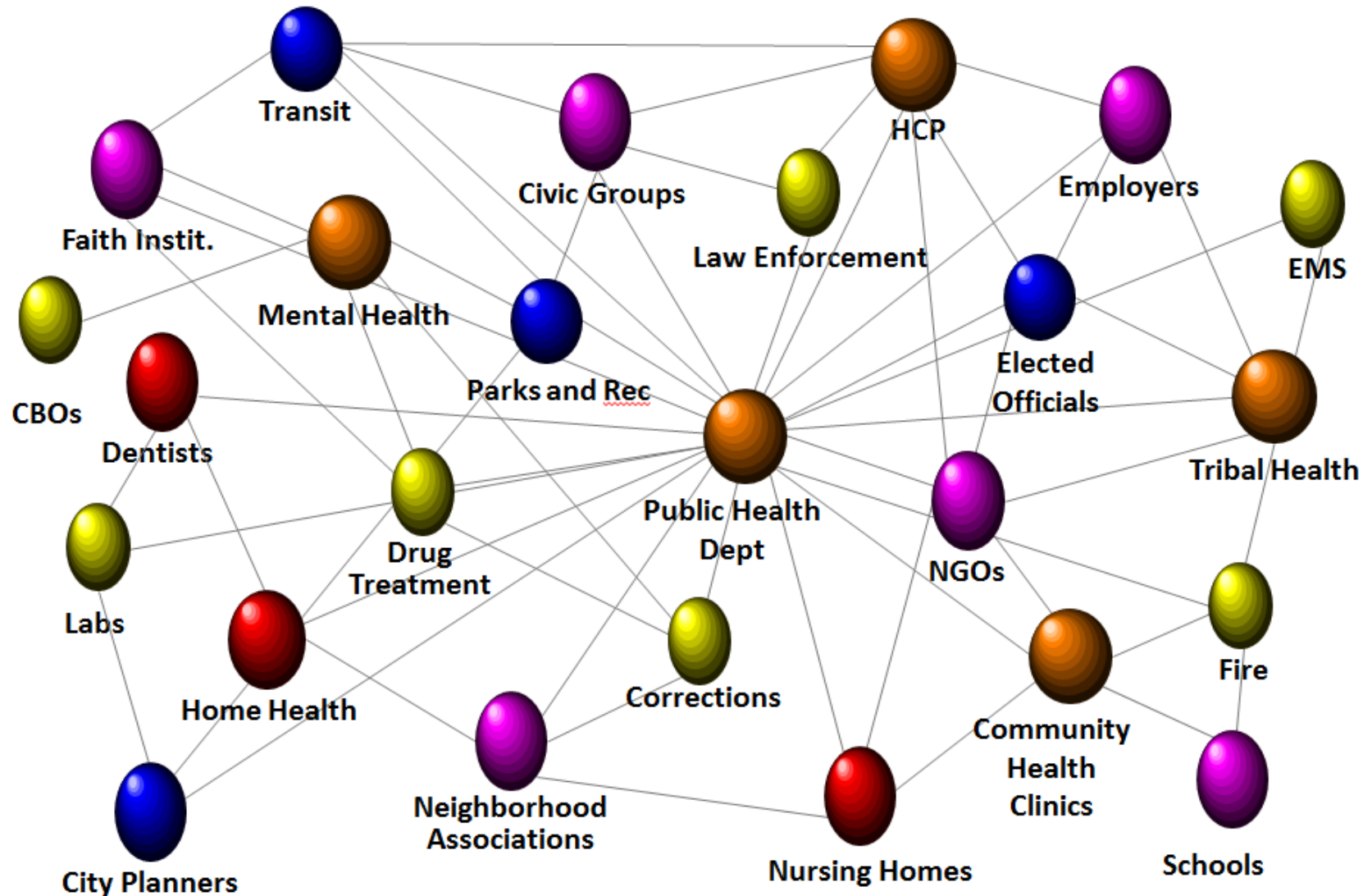


In a nutshell, it is a QI process aligned with our existing work.

Local Public Health System

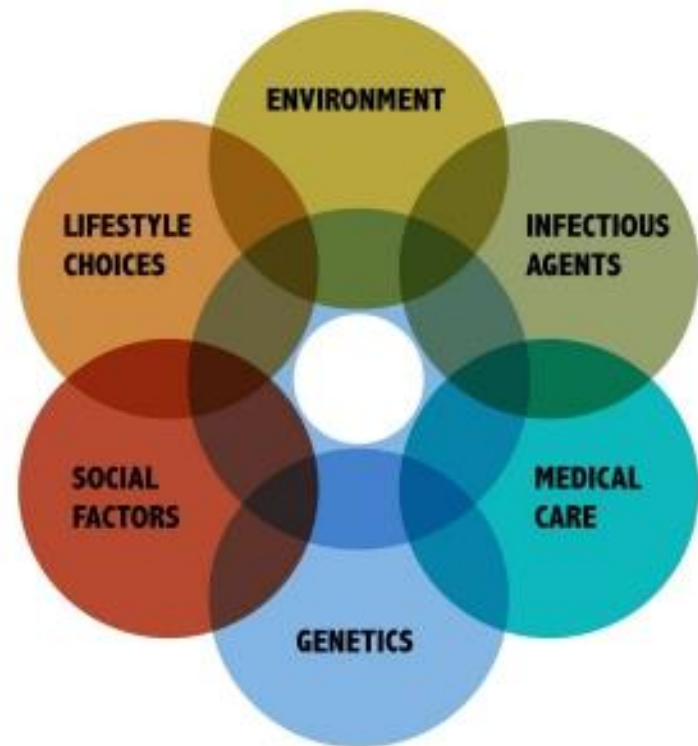
