SUBJECT: Resolution approving execution of Amendment 1 to the Contract with Victor Community Services, Inc for the provision of counseling and psychiatric services to adjust line items with the maximum contract price not changing, for a maximum price of \$363,040 and revise Exhibit "B", Schedule of Charges and Payments to reflect the line item adjustments for the term of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. (RES. 24-373)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: The services are funded with Child Welfare Allocation funds, CalWORKs Single Allocation funds and department realignment funds as needed. Services are within the department's FY 2024/25 budget and there are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: On July 9, 2024, per Resolution 24-373, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorized the execution of the Professional Services Contract between the County of Nevada and Victor Community Services, Inc for the provision of counseling and psychiatric services. The services provided will ensure access to preventative and early intervention services to support the safety and wellbeing of children and families who are engaged with Child Welfare Services and CalWORKs by providing timely and evidenced based assessments, psychotherapy, and psychiatric services. Many of the services provided will be court-ordered to facilitate reunification of families.

The only change to this amendment is to address needed line-item adjustments in the budget, or Exhibit B. The scope and services remain the same.

It is recommended that the Board approve this Amendment, as the services provided will

continue to support children and families in Nevada County.
