



# RESOLUTION No. 23-287

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

### RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RATE STUDY FOR UNINCORPORATED EASTERN NEVADA COUNTY SOLID WASTE PARCEL CHARGE

WHEREAS, Nevada County provides mandatory solid waste collection within the unincorporated portion of Eastern Nevada County, provided by Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal (TTSD) under an exclusive franchise agreement and services are billed to approximately 860 residential property owners through the property tax bill; and

WHEREAS, the County is responsible for collecting the residential tax roll revenue and remitting the agreed upon compensation to TTSD and a portion of the parcel charge is retained by the County to cover administrative and post closure costs; and

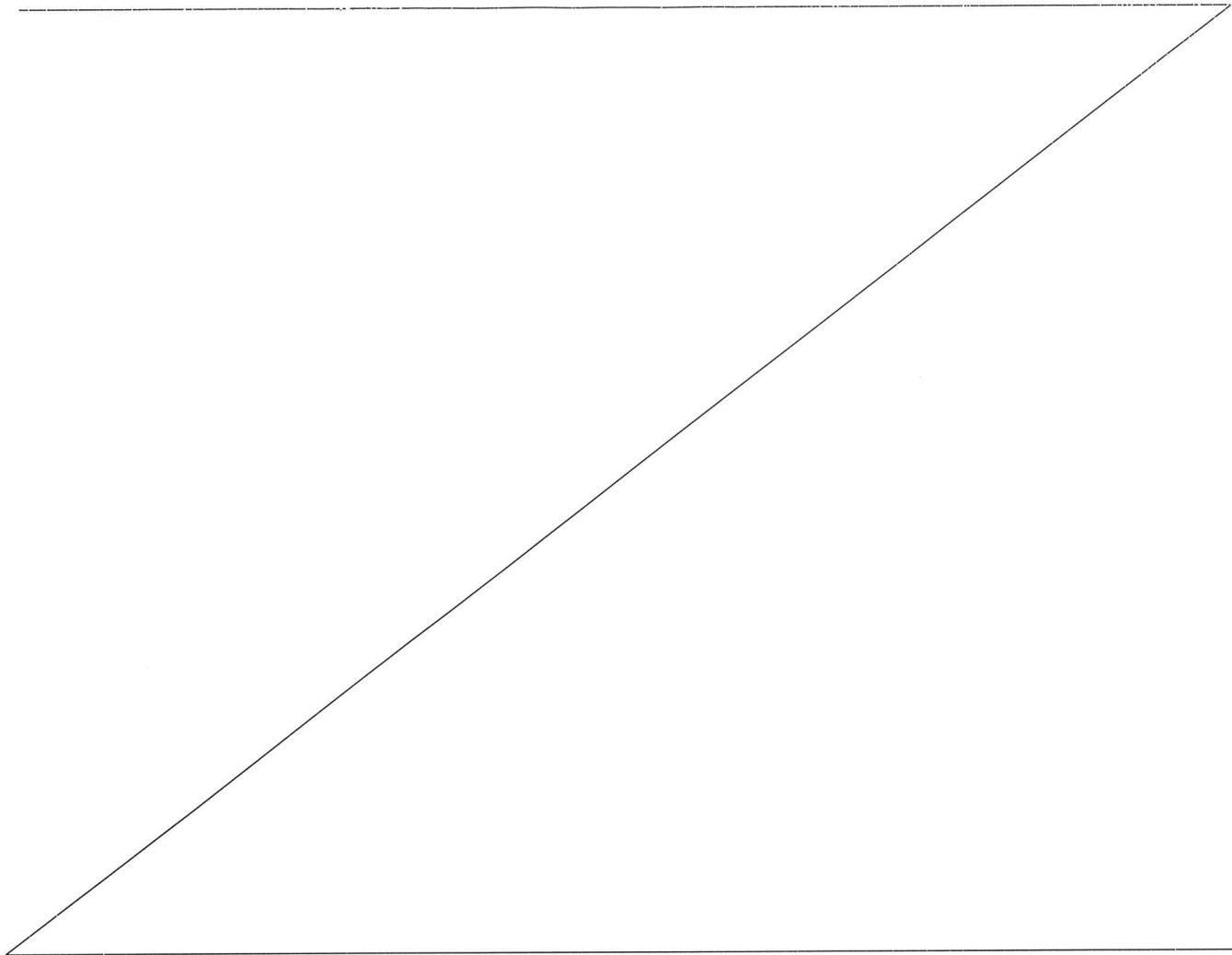
WHEREAS, budgetary needs required a comprehensive Solid Waste Parcel Charge Fee Study for Eastern Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2022, per Resolution 22-010, the Board of Supervisors awarded a contract to HF&H Consulting LLC. to conduct a solid waste parcel charge fee study; and

WHEREAS, the fee Study proposes increased annual charges for five consecutive fiscal years (Fiscal Year 2023/24 through Fiscal Year 2027/28); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21080(b)(8) of the California Public Resource Code, the proposed rates are derived directly from the cost of providing service and necessary to meet operating expenses; and are therefore exempt from environmental review.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors accepts the Rate Study for Eastern Nevada County Solid Waste Parcel Charge attached as Exhibit A.
