RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES GRANT AWARD XC23060290 FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$144,820 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2024 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024, AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY, OR THEIR ASSIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT AND ALL ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS TO FULFILL THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) has awarded the County of Nevada District Attorney's Office State Federal Victim of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cal OES grant award is comprised of Federal VOCA funds in the amount of \$144,820 and have been made available for the grant period of January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024; and

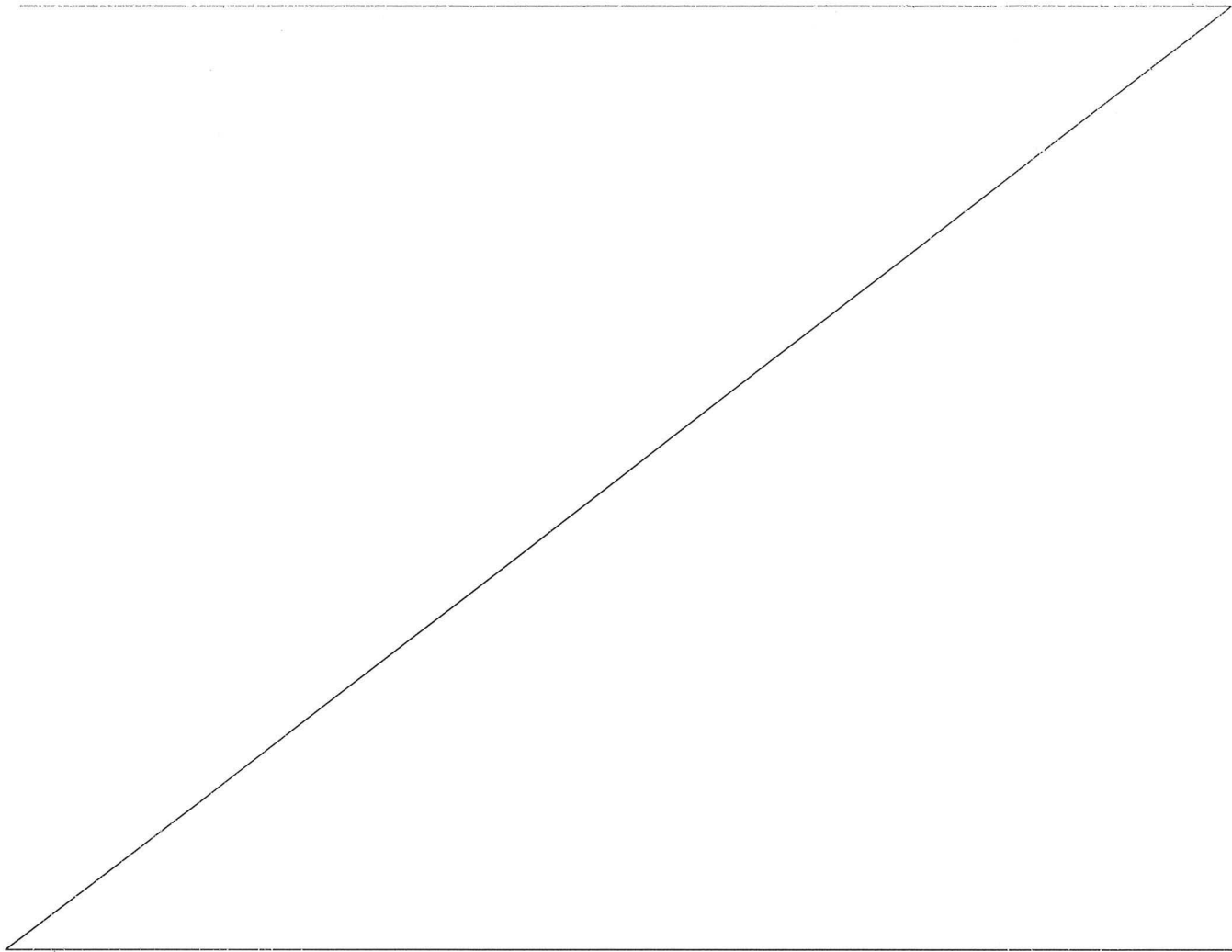


