**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE JUNE 2, 2026, STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION FOR THE COUNTY OF NEVADA, AS SUBMITTED ON THE CERTIFIED STATEMENT OF VOTES PREPARED BY THE COUNTY CLERK-RECORDER/REGISTRAR OF VOTERS**

WHEREAS, California Elections Code section 15372 requires the Nevada County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters to prepare a certified statement of election results within the county and submit it to the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters did canvass the returns of the June 2, 2026 Statewide Direct Primary Election, and has certified the results of the votes cast at said election, which results are provided in accompanying documents for reference; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code section 15400 provides that the Board of Supervisors must declare elected to each office voted on at each election under its jurisdiction the person who receives a majority of all ballots cast for candidates for that office and must also declare the results of each election under its jurisdiction as to each measure voted on at the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada declares the following results of the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election, as submitted on the certified Statement of Votes prepared by the Nevada County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters, which is attached hereto and incorporated by this reference:
