RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) NEVADA COUNTY (NEVCO) 2017 BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017/18 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$26,000

WHEREAS, the Farm Advisor Division of the Community Development Agency administers and delivers the Master Gardeners of Nevada County Program in cooperation with the University of California; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the contract is budgeted in the Fiscal Year 2017/18 Farm Advisor budget in budget code 0101-60301-781-1000/521520.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada approves Agreement Number MOA NevCo 2017 between the County of Nevada and the Regents of the University of California, Agriculture and Natural Resources and authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute the agreement for Fiscal Year 2017/18 in the amount of \$26,000.

Agreement No. MOA NevCo 2017

THIS AGREEMENT is made on the date last signed below by and between THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, Agriculture and Natural Resources (hereinafter called "University") and the COUNTY OF NEVADA (hereinafter called "County").

The parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. <u>SCOPE OF WO</u>RK. University shall provide Master Gardener services and educational activities within the county. County shall provide payment for services (as listed in Term 5, below) in accordance with the attached budget and scope of services.
- 2. <u>TERM.</u> The term of this Agreement shall be from July 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.
- 3. <u>TERMINATION</u>. This Agreement shall be subject to termination by either party at any time, upon providing thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. Upon the giving of notice of termination by either party, University shall exert its reasonable efforts to limit or to terminate any outstanding financial commitments. County shall reimburse University for all allowable costs incurred by it for the Scope of Work, including without limitation all uncancellable obligations. University shall prepare, within ninety (90) days after the termination date, a report of all expenditures incurred and of all funds received hereunder and shall reimburse County for funds which may have been advanced in excess of total costs incurred.
- 4. <u>ALTERATION AMENDMENT</u>. No alteration of the terms of this Agreement shall be valid or binding upon either party unless made in writing and signed by both parties. This Agreement may be amended at any time by mutual agreement of the parties, expressed in writing and signed by both parties.
- 5. <u>COMPENSATION.</u> The County shall pay the University a fixed amount of Twenty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$26,000) to be payable quarterly in equal installments of \$6,500. University's central accounting office shall submit invoices to Cindy Mitchell, UCCE Placer/Nevada, 11477 E Avenue, Auburn, CA 95603, cmitchell@ucanr.edu. County shall make checks payable to "The Regents of the University of California", include a reference this agreement by number, and mail the payments to the following address:

- 6. The Parties shall defend, indemnify and hold each other harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, expense, attorney's fees, or claims for injury or damages arising out of the performance of this agreement but only in proportion to and to the extent such liability, loss, expense, attorney's fees, or claims for injury or damages are caused by or result from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of the indemnifying party or its officers, agents, or employees.
- 7. <u>NOTICE</u>. All notices concerning this Agreement shall be effective only if made in writing personally delivered or deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid and addressed as follows:
