**BACKGROUND:**

Every ten years, local governments use new census data to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have changed. Assembly Bill 849 (2019) requires cities and counties to engage communities in the redistricting process by holding public hearings and/or workshops and doing public outreach. In Nevada County, the Board of Supervisors is responsible for drawing supervisorial districts. Redistricting is done using U.S. Census data, which is released around October 20, 2021. For the County of Nevada, the redistricting process must be completed by December 15<sup>th</sup>.

On July 29, 2021 the Information and General Services Agency held the 1<sup>st</sup> of 4 Public Workshops at 6:00 pm where members of the public received this presentation and were able to ask questions and provide community input. At this August 24<sup>th</sup> meeting the Board of Supervisors and public will receive a presentation from our consultant Douglas Yoakam of the National Demographics Corporation on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw Board of Supervisors election district boundaries. The public hearing will be to receive public input on communities of interest, potential district boundaries, and address any questions. This is the second of four public forums conducted throughout the redistricting process.
