**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing the Sheriff to submit an application to the California Department of Parks and Recreation for an Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Grant and execute award if granted

---

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

**FUNDING:** If received state funding would be for FY 17/18 and impact the Sheriff's Office Operations budget.

**BACKGROUND:** The State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division, requires the attached resolution, to apply for grant funding for off-highway vehicle programs. If this application is approved by the state, the county will receive approximately \$17,000 in grant funding for FY 2017-2018 to provide off-highway vehicle law enforcement services. The Sheriff's Office will provide approximately 25 percent of the total project cost in matching funds represented by staff time, equipment expenses and administrative costs.

This grant will help pay for OHV patrols in outlying areas, during high-traffic holidays in problematic areas. Press releases and public notices have been posted to make the public aware of the grant application and planned OHV patrols.
