**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with Sierra

County for the provision of booking and jail services for Sierra County inmates at the Nevada County Jail, to extend the term by one year from

July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024. (Res 20-454)

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: This is an amendment to extend the existing revenue agreement for one year with payment by Sierra County to the Sheriff's Corrections Budget. Revenues are expected to cover expenses. There is no negative impact to the General fund.

## **BACKGROUND**:

The Sierra County Jail does not qualify as a Type II housing facility to house inmates for extended periods of time. Nevada County had housed Sierra County arrestees under an agreement authorized by Resolution 12-353, as amended. The Agreement was renewed in FY 19/20 for a three-year term with an option to renew for two additional fiscal years. This proposed Amendment No. 1 exercises the first of the two one-year options to renew and extends the agreement through FY 23/24. The daily rate for housing an inmate remains unchanged at \$136.00.

Nevada County must approve acceptance of the inmates at its jail in advance and may in its sole discretion decline to accept any arrestee. Sierra County generally delivers their arrestees to our Truckee Jail and then our transport officers bring the inmates down to the WBCF. Nevada County reserves the right to return any inmate to Sierra County at its sole discretion.
