OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO REQUEST RELINQUISHMENT OF STATE RIGHT-OF-WAY, SPECIFICALLY PORTIONS OF SOUTH PONDEROSA WAY AND DEADMANS FLAT ROAD, TO THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND TO ACCEPT THE RELINQUISHED RIGHT-OF-WAY ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA (DISTRICT IV)

WHEREAS, as part of the construction of Highway 20 between Grass Valley and Penn Valley, the State acquired right-of-way (ROW) on adjoining local roads including South Ponderosa Way and Deadmans Flat Road; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans has requested to relinquish these roads to the County of Nevada by condition of approval on a Caltrans Encroachment Permit to install bollards in the vicinity of South Ponderosa Way and State Route 20; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved an associated Maintenance Agreement with Caltrans per Resolution 20-458; and


WHEREAS, on November 3, 2020, Caltrans issued an encroachment permit to install bollards for emergency egress/ingress with a condition of approval for the County to accept the relinquished roads; and

WHEREAS, if the California Transportation Commission (CTC) approves the requested relinquishment, the roads would be accepted by the County but not accepted into the County's Maintained Mileage System at this time; and

WHEREAS, if the CTC authorizes the relinquishment, the County will be asked to accept the relinquished ROW by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Authorizes the Director of Public Works to request relinquishment of State right-of-way as described and depicted in the attached Exhibit A.
- 2. Authorizes the Director of Public Works to accept the relinquished right-of-way on behalf of the County of Nevada.


The County of Nevada has received Caltrans Encroachment Permit #20-0961 to construct bollards at S. Ponderosa Way and Mushroom Trail for emergency egress/ingress purposes. Per condition of approval for the permit, the County of Nevada is requesting relinquishment of a portion of S. Ponderosa Way and Deadmans Flat Road.

The County understands that the property to be relinquished will be transferred with no compensation by either party. The attached exhibit identifies the property to be relinquished from the State to the County. The Board of Supervisors has reviewed the proposed relinquishment and has approved a resolution for the transfer. A copy of the resolution has been attached to this letter for your files.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 21-020, dated January 26, 2021, the County of Nevada agreed to accept title to highway right of way, consisting of relocated and reconstructed local roads, upon relinquishment thereof to said County by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, by letter signed April 21, 2021, the County waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title to said collateral facilities, consisting of relocated and reconstructed local roads, upon relinquishment thereof to said County by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has acquired right of way for and has constructed the above-mentioned collateral facilities in the County of Nevada along

WHEREAS, this Commission has found and determined, and does hereby find and determine, that it is desirable and in the public interest that said collateral facilities be relinquished to the County of Nevada for use as county roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS VOTED by the California Transportation

Commission that it relinquish, and it does hereby relinquish, to the County of Nevada, effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of Nevada County, all of the State of California's right, title and interest in and to said collateral facilities in said County, together with the right of way and appurtenances thereof, described as follows:

Segments 1 and 2 as shown on RELINQUISHMENT MAP NO. 038088-X filed for record on April 23, 2021 in State Highway Map Book 6 at page 1, Records of Nevada County.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING to the State of California any and all rights of ingress to and egress from the highway hereby relinquished in and to the adjacent and adjoining freeway, except at such points as now are or may be established by resolution of this Commission.
