SUBJECT: (Waive Further Reading/Adopt) An Ordinance Amending, Adding,

and Repealing Non-Substantive Sections of the Nevada County

Sanitation District Code

RECOMMENDATION: The proposed Ordinance was introduced at the October 10, 2023 Board of Supervisor meeting. It is now recommended to waive further reading and adopt the proposed Ordinance.

FUNDING: The revision will have no fiscal effect.

BACKGROUND:

The Sanitation District Code of the County of Nevada was last fully updated in 2011 by Ordinance No. SD-072. In an effort to create uniformity in internal referencing, language usage, updated pronouns, as well as to verify accuracy of citation and comport with California State Statute, County Counsel's Office has been working with county Agencies and Departments and proposes the following revisions.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Board adopt this proposed Ordinance to:

Revise:

<u>Sections 1 through 8</u> of the Nevada County Sanitation District Code to read as shown in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

- 1. "General Provisions" Sections 1.1-1.8;
- 2. "Regulation of Connections"; Sections 2.1-2.9;
- 3. "Regulations of Discharges"; Sections 3.1-.3.
- 4. "User Fees and Charges", Sections 4.1-4.7;
- 5. "Equivalent Dwelling Units"; Sections 5.1-5.4; .

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- 6. "Code Compliance, Inspection and Violation Penalty Provisions"; Sections 6.1-6.4;
- 7. "Design and Construction Standards", Sections 7.1-7.10;
- 8. Annexation Policy", Sections 8.1-8.4.

All of the above sections contain non-substantive revisions that update language to reflect established practices within the department. Revisions include standardizing citation of California statute, removal of the terms "Chapter", "Land Use," "General Code," and "Article" within the body of the code, conform format for dates of prior Ordinance, gender neutrality, replace internal references from number of code section to title of code section, identify numbers by name and numerical symbols. Sections throughout containing "Purpose" and "Severability" are repealed. Purpose descriptions remain in the original Ordinance.
