BACKGROUND:

Currently, there are four vacancies and two positions open on the Mental Health and Substance Use Advisory Board: two member positions for the Mental Health and Substance Use Advisory Board for three-year terms ending June 30, 2028. One member vacancy to fill three-year term ending June 30, 2027, and two member vacancies to fill three-year terms ending June 30, 2028. These vacancies can be filled by Consumer, Family or General Members. These vacancies were advertised and posted for a minimum of ten days at the following places: the Board of Supervisors Chambers Bulletin Board, in the Board of Supervisors Office, Truckee Town Hall, the District V Board of Supervisors office in Truckee, and on the County website.
