RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CAPITAL ASSET PURCHASE OF A NEW AIR CONDITIONING UNIT TO REPLACE THE CURRENT SWAMP COOLER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,058 FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER AND DIRECTS THE AUDITOR CONTROLLER TO AMEND THE FISCAL YEAR 2024/25 ANIMAL SHELTER BUDGET (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, animal shelter services are a core service for the Nevada County community; and

WHEREAS, Sammie's Friends has provided contracted animal shelter services to the County of Nevada since 2010; and

WHEREAS, animal shelter services are dedicated to saving and improving the lives of animals through adoptions, veterinary services, educational programs, and behavior modification or socialization programs; and

WHEREAS, air quality and temperature are important factors in the health and well-being of animals and staff; and

WHEREAS, the current cooling system at Sammie's Friends does not cool the facility to an acceptable level and contributes to conditions conducive to mold and pests; and

WHEREAS, the Animal Shelter Fiscal Year 2024/p25 budget has sufficient funds to make a Capital Asset purchase and installation in the amount of \$23,058 for a new air conditioning unit therefore the budget amendment only moves the funds to the capital equipment account code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby authorizes the capital asset purchase of a new air conditioning unit to replace the current swamp cooler in the amount of \$23,058 for the Nevada County Animal Shelter and directs the Auditor Controller to amend the Animal Shelter Fiscal Year 2024/25 budget as follows:


