




## What is SERi?

- A non-profit established in Western Nevada County in 2024
  - Inherited funding from the Clean Power Co- op (CPC) of Nevada County formed in 2006
  - Two members of the NC Energy Action Plan
    Working Group (EAP WG) responded to CPCs call for new board members
- With a revised mission, SERi incorporated as a 501- c3 charitable organization
  - Registered our new name with the IRS and completed other administrative actions
  - Four additional members of the NC EAP WG are now active volunteers in SERi








### Mission/Vision/Strategy

  - Together they develop a plan and identify incentives for home energy improvements
- Home Energy Wise Workshop
  - A Home Energy Analytics (HEA) Specialist from Home Intel taught workshop attendees how to **Save Energy.Save Money**. Worksheets were provided
  - Reed Hamilton, a SERi volunteer who conducted several home energy efficiency visits, presented practical tips for conserving energy. Reed is also a member of the EAP WG
- Home Energy Coach In the Library
  - Rob Katzenstein owner of Power Structures in Grass Valley, President and founder of the former CPC, answers questions on interpreting power bills and offers ways to reduce energy usage
- SERi newsletter and website
  - Provide seasonal weatherization tips and information on upcoming events




### "The Air They Breathe"






