## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

### RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING APRIL 2026 AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH IN NEVADA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Act, enacted on April 11, 1968, enshrined in federal law the goal of eliminating racial segregation and ending housing discrimination in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing based on race, color, religion, sex, familial status, national origin, and disability, and commits recipients of federal funding to affirmatively further fair housing in their communities; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is committed to the mission and intent of Congress to provide fair and equal housing opportunities for all; and

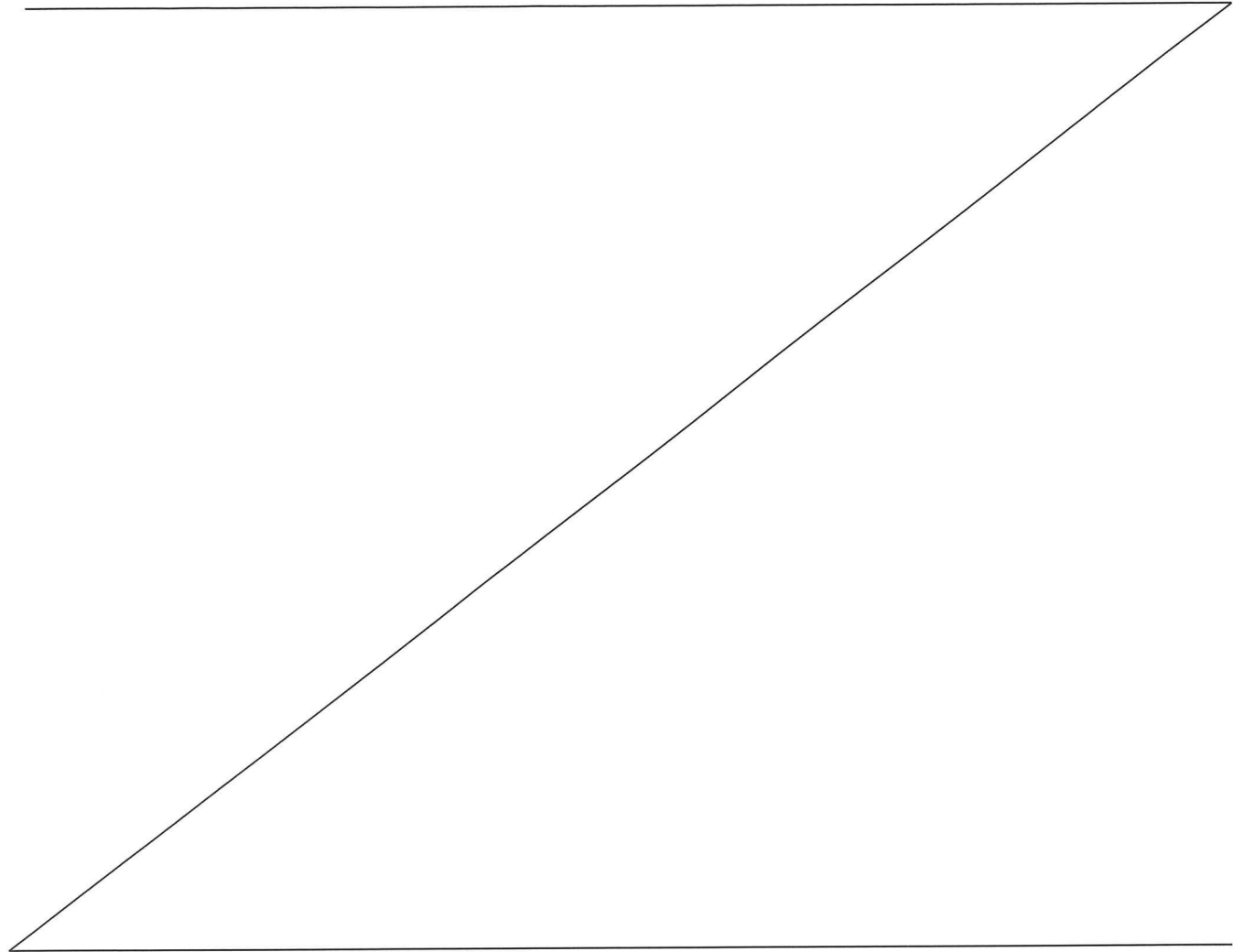
WHEREAS, our social fabric, economy, health, and environment are strengthened in diverse and inclusive communities; and

WHEREAS, more than fifty years after the passage of the Fair Housing Act, discrimination persists and many communities remain segregated; and

WHEREAS, equal housing opportunity is a condition of life in our county that can and should be achieved; and

WHEREAS, communities must make every effort to promote a sense of decency and fairness through affirming fair housing for all.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims April 2026, as Fair Housing Month in Nevada County to affirmatively further fair housing for the community.


