



In the Works—1 Year Navigation Center

Pilot
- Location: 1235 Deerfield Drive (behind Taco
Bell)

• Estimated Cost: \$1.2M

• Number served: Up to 16

Services:

Case management, meals, services on site

- 6 interim beds (longer term, individual spaces)
- 10 congregate shelter beds
- 24/7, 365 days a year





TTHAC Navigation Center 1-Year Pilot Model Proposed Next Steps:

- Town of Truckee and Tahoe Forest Hospital District need to approve project location, design and funding model – Joint Board meeting today
- 2. Nevada County is beginning lease negotiations for 12315 Deerfield Drive Property
- 3. With a clear invitation from the Town, including The Town passing a resolution waiving the 60 day notification requirement, Nevada County will invoke Development Code Section 18.02.025.
- 4. Further negotiation amongst partners will occur regarding operational contract with VOA
