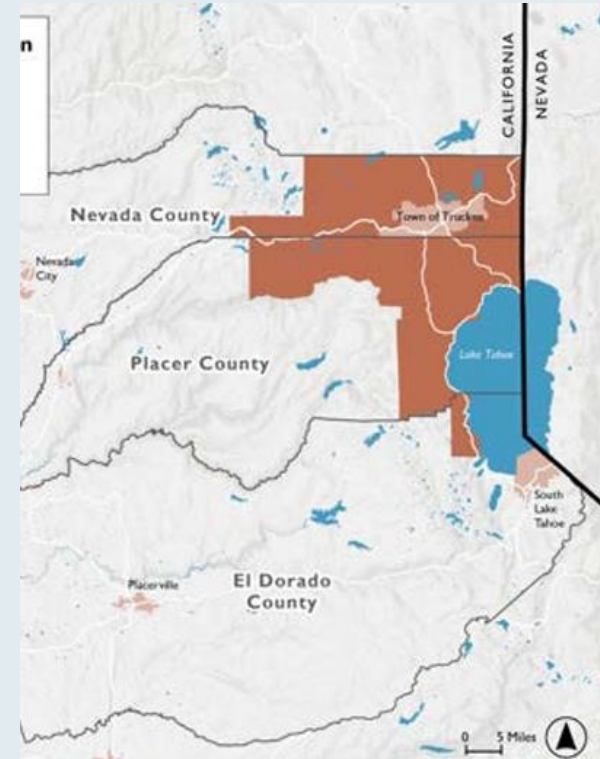

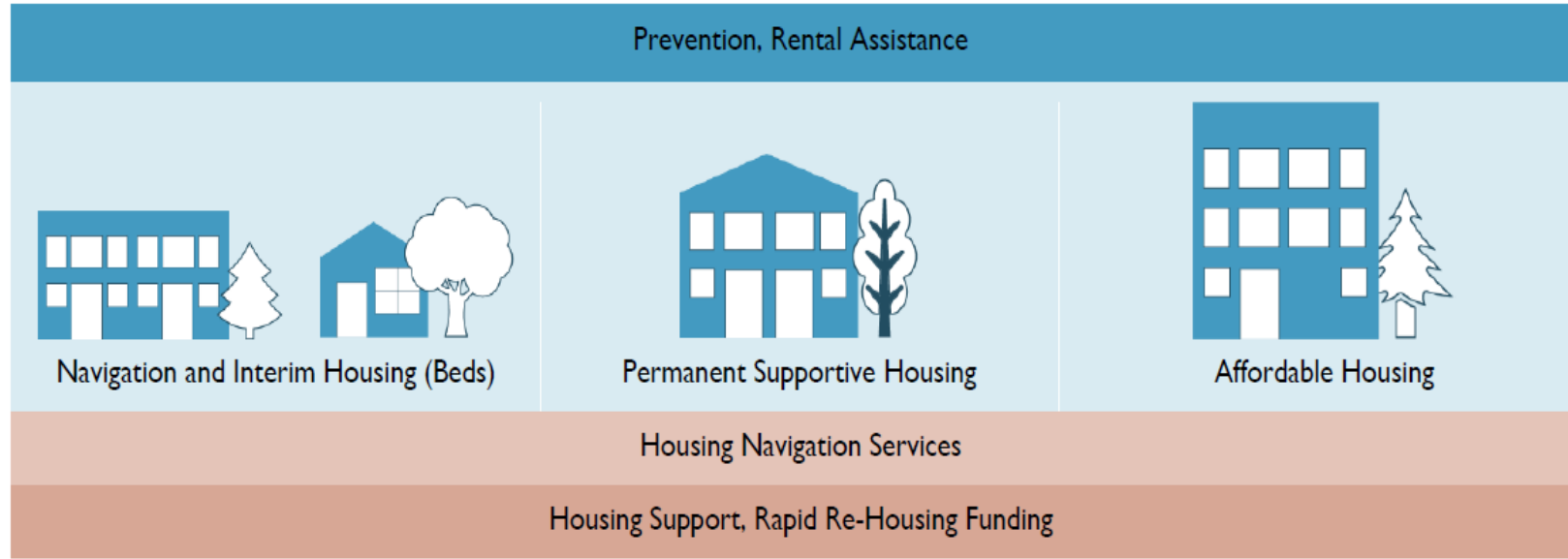

In the Works—1 Year Navigation Center Pilot

- **Location:** 1235 Deerfield Drive (behind Taco Bell)
- **Estimated Cost:** \$1.2M
- **Number served:** Up to 16
- **Services:**
 - Case management, meals, services on site
 - 6 interim beds (longer term, individual spaces)
 - 10 congregate shelter beds
 - 24/7, 365 days a year

TTHAC Navigation Center 1-Year Pilot Model Proposed Next Steps:

1. Town of Truckee and Tahoe Forest Hospital District need to approve project location, design and funding model – Joint Board meeting today
2. Nevada County is beginning lease negotiations for 12315 Deerfield Drive Property
3. With a clear invitation from the Town, including The Town passing a resolution waiving the 60 day notification requirement, Nevada County will invoke Development Code Section 18.02.025.
4. Further negotiation amongst partners will occur regarding operational contract with VOA
